Dear Parents / Carers

We are delighted to have been able to plan a residential trip to Sherwood Forest in March which will consist of two days with an overnight stay.

The residential visits will take place between **Monday 13th and Thursday 16th March 2023.** The children will be going in their classes for two of the days during this week. Details of the exact days will be sent to you nearer the time.

The children will leave for Sherwood Forest at the beginning of the school day and return by home time of the next day. Whilst on the residential, they will be involved in a variety of fun and educational activities linked to our topics which we know they will enjoy. The children will develop a range of skills including creating wild art and shelter building as well as developing the life skills that come with staying away from home. They will deepen their knowledge of our History topic for the Spring term (Stone Age to the Iron Age) as well as learning about artists such as Andy Goldsworthy.

The cost for the residential trip is £85.00, which will include transport, meals, accommodation and all the activities.
