Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons will start on Monday 11th September for children in Hornbeams and Hawthorns and Thursday 14th September for children in Willows and Maples. The children will be going swimming until October half term. All swimming lessons will take place at the swimming pool at Market Rasen C of E Primary School.

The Hornbeams and Hawthorns children will swim on a Monday morning, travelling by bus accompanied by Mrs Watson, Mrs Suddaby, Mrs Crawford, Mrs Vaughan and a parent helper. They will be taught by Mr Toothill and Mrs Watson, who are both qualified swimming instructors.

The children in Willows and Maples will also travel by bus accompanied by Mrs Jones or Mrs Parry, Miss Creek, Mrs Crump, Mr McDermid and a parent helper on a Thursday afternoon, they will be taught by Mr Toothill. While the children are not swimming they will be engaged in a learning activity.

To cover the cost of transport we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £2.00 per child per week to help meet the transport costs (no child may be excluded from this activity due to nonpayment). If your child is unable to swim one particular week, they will have to still travel on the bus and the cost per child is still £2.00. The children will be swimming for 6 weeks, therefore the cost for this term per child is £12.00, please make all payments on Wisepay (payment system available from next week), if you are unable to do this please speak to Mrs Hydes or Mrs Fussey.
