London Residential September 2024

After a very much enjoyed trip in 2022 we are running the London Residential again for Year 5/6 children in September 2024. We will be taking the children for a 2 night, 3 day residential. This will be an amazing opportunity for the children to learn about History, Geography and British values.

All Year 5 and 6 children at both Market Rasen and Nettleton will be invited to attend. Nettleton and one Market Rasen class would go Monday - Wednesday and two Market Rasen classes will go Wednesday to Friday. The children would stay at the YHA, St Pauls Cathedral. We expect to have the whole floor of the accommodation to ourselves for security. Dates:

This is a 3 day and 2 night trip visit. There will be two identical trips:

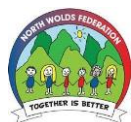
Cost:

The cost for this trip is expected to be around £250 including accommodation, food and attraction entry costs. This cost also includes a wristband with contact details for security, and a brightly coloured hat the children will be required to wear for easy identification.

Payment Stages:

- **By 31st January 2024 -£25 deposit.**
- 50% of the balance **must** be paid by April 2024 (further £112.50) and the final (£112.50) balance by September 2024
- Wisepay will also have set up a monthly instalment option of
8 Monthly instalments : February -September 2024 of £28.12 per month

Booking:

Booking a place on this trip will be available on Wisepay from Monday 8th January 2024 and will close on Wednesday 31st January 2024.

We have 100 spaces for a cohort of 124 so spaces are limited and strictly first come first served. A

£25 non-refundable deposit will be needed when booking.

Once numbers are then finalised and deposits received, we will set up the remaining balance on Wisepay to be paid as listed above.
