



Sports Premium Funding April 2015 to March 2016

In the above period we expect to receive £8272 in sports premium funding.

The table below outlines how we intend to spend this income.

| Proposed Spend | Cost | Expected Impact |

| Membership into the Wolds Federation School Sports Partnership. | £2095 | Access to quality training in all aspects of P.E; teachers more skilled in the teaching of P.E Access to sporting competitions and Tournaments; children partake in more competitive sport than before. Access to Bikeability cycle proficiency scheme; fitness and safety for our Y5 children. |
| Sport Coaching | £4140 | Specialist coaches; used to up skill teachers and support staff in the teaching of different areas of the curriculum. Note: This is not used for PPA cover but for staff development. |
| Transport to take our youngest children swimming | £1,485 | Transport to improve our swimming offer to our youngest children (reception) who otherwise would not go; sessions develop water safety skills, water confidence and swimming skills. Note: The cost of the use of the pool and the teaching is met by our partner school, Market Rasen Church of England Primary School. |
| Fencing Equipment | £600 | Equipment to enable us to deliver this enjoyable and exciting extracurricular activity; improves children's fitness, agility and self-confidence. |
